Information and application

The Feminist to the Core Undergraduate Essay Prize is awarded annually to the undergraduate who is judged by the IRWGS prize committee to have written the best essay on any topic in Feminist or Queer Studies in one of the following Core courses:

- Literature Humanities
- Contemporary Civilization
- Art Humanities
- Music Humanities.

Eligibility

1. Award candidates must be undergraduates currently enrolled in Barnard College, Columbia College, the School of General Studies (except post-Bac programs), or the School of Engineering and Applied Science.
2. Essays may not exceed 7 pages.
3. Essays must have been written in any one of the following Core courses: Literature Humanities, Contemporary Civilization, Art Humanities, or Music Humanities.
4. Only one entry per student.
5. Students may submit work for consideration in any of the IRWGS prize competitions -- the Women's and Gender Studies Prize, the Feminist to the Core Prize, and the Queer Studies Prize. However, the same essay may not be submitted for consideration in more than one competition.

Submission and Prize Information

1. Submission deadline is **5:00pm, Thursday, March 15th, 2018. No late submissions will be accepted.**
2. **Essays** may be sent via email in PDF format to the Institute for Research on Women, Gender, and Sexuality, irwgs@columbia.edu.
3. Essays must be double-spaced in standard paper format (12-point, one-inch margins, page numbers, and full references and citations). Include art or links to other media, if necessary. All essays must have a title.
4. Submissions are anonymous. Names must not appear anywhere in the submission. ***Essays with any identifying information will be disqualified.*** **Name and contact information** should appear on the Application Cover Sheet only.
5. Cash prize is \$250.
6. All decisions are final.
